



2023 Entries for the Hawkesbury Show

Just another reminder about the Hawkesbury Agriculture - please note the change of action in note number 4 below. Closing date for entries - Tuesday 11th April. Date for taking entries to the show – Friday 21st April or Saturday 22nd April between the hours of 10.00 am and 4.00 pm – Enter via gate 3. Date for pickup of entries after the show - Monday 1st May between 12.30 and 6.00pm. What else do you need to know and do?

1. If you want me to take your entries to the show, then bring them to the Lace day at Linnwood on the first Sunday of April

2. You will need your name and contact details on your entry when you give them to me to be taken to the show. (NOTE: You do not need a receipt – your name is enough for the steward at the show to match it with your show paperwork)

3. I do need a note allowing me to pick up your items from the show if you can't go and pick them up yourself. So, you will need to mention my name – Robyn Cocks

4. I need a note to pick up any prize money you may have won, as I won't be able to pick that up without your permission
